14.15h From Delves Park to Cleghorn Bridge and back, via New Lanark, Racecourse, Smyllum Drive, Carstairs Road. Ends Ladyacre Road.

17.15h Massed bands lead equestrian procession from Ladyacre Road to Cross (High Street (S))

17.30h *Lord Cornet's Declaration at Cross.*

17.15-18.30h Massed Bands' at the Cross, including *Beating Retreat*

19.15h Lanark Memorial Hall
