Sunday 7th June: Kirkin' of Lord Cornet Elect Gordon R. Gray in St Nicholas Parish Church at 12.00 noon. A Procession will form at 11.35am outside the Lanark Memorial Hall made up of members of: The Lord Cornets' Club, the Royal Burgh of Lanark Community Council, New Lanark Village Group, The Guildry of Lanark, The Lanark Lanimer Committee, Councillors & Officials of South Lanarkshire Council. *Service is open to members of the public.*

Monday 8th June: 6.00pm Perambulation of the Marches leaves Lanark Sheriff Court, Hope Street, at 6.00pm and proceeds via Waterloo Road, Stey Brae to Woodend where Birks will be distributed at 6.35pm. Perambulation continues via Leechford, Jerviswood Fields, Cleghorn Road, Linthill, Laverockhall, Potters Wynd to St Leonard Street. 8.00pm Equestrian Procession from St Leonard Street led by the Lord Cornet, Lord Cornet Elect and Supporters. Riders assemble at Lanark Racecourse and proceed to Ross of Lanark Garage for 7.45pm.

8.15pm The Shifting of the Standard Ceremony at the Cross and Sashing of the Lord Cornet by Mrs Eleanor McLean

Tuesday 9th June: 4.30pm Lord Cornet's Official Ride Out 'Safe Out Safe In' at the Cross then riders set off for first part of the Ride Out via High Street, South Vennel, Delves Road, Delves Park and proceed to Mousemill via Castlegate, St Patricks Road, Clydesholm Braes, Kirkfieldbank Brae, Mousemill Road, Nemphlar, Rothesbank, Lockhartbank and East Gate Lodge.

5.40pm Riders return to Delves Park, then Wellgatehead, Braxfield Road to Clearburn, Bonnington Mains, Robiesland and Lady Mary, then riding up the Beeches, Hyndford Road, Home Street, Whitelees Road to Lanark Golf Club, through Lanark Golf Course, up the Sandy Brae to Lanark Racecourse.

6.40pm Traditional Lanimer Chases at Lanark Racecourse.

7.40pm Leaving the Racecourse the riders turn left onto Hyndford Road before turning immediately right into Robiesland Road towards New Lanark via Robiesland Farm into the Lady Mary then to New Lanark arriving approx. 8.00pm.
